① WIDOWS

Being a widow is not a stigma in Pakistan either in religion or under the law. Marriage in Islam, which is the religion followed by the majority of the population, is not considered as sacrosanct. It is viewed as a civil contract between two individuals which can be dissolved. Thus the extreme sanctity attached to marriage in certain other religions does not operate to turn a widow into an outcast or be held responsible for her husband's death. Traditionally, widows have been encouraged to re-marry and marriage to a widow has always been considered as an honorable act.

For many of Pakistani widows and orphans, the pain is compounded by the daily struggle it takes to simply keep a roof over their heads. Though the primary breadwinner is gone, bills still come and rent is still demanded. Lives that have been broken take time to put back together, but widows and orphans are not given that luxury.

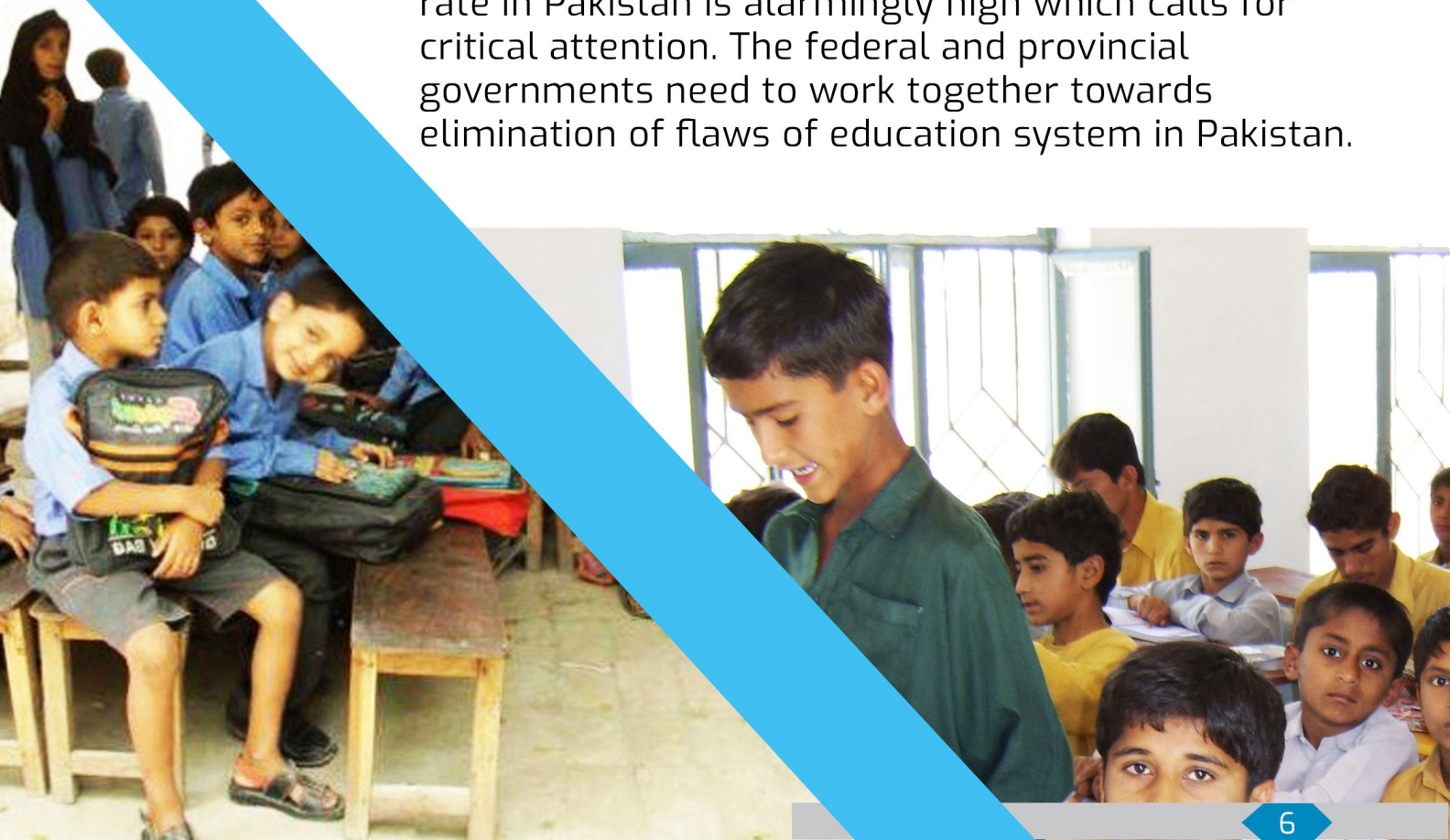




② EDUCATION

RMWO is non-profit & educational welfare organization. Education is the key of development. It is one of the most powerful instruments for reducing poverty and in equality and lays a foundation for sustained economic growth.

In today's world, the bench marks for excellence in education. Moreover, if a country has a distraught academic infrastructure, the chances to survive in current competitive world are petite. The illiteracy rate in Pakistan is alarmingly high which calls for critical attention. The federal and provincial governments need to work together towards elimination of flaws of education system in Pakistan.





③ FOOD DISTRIBUTION

RMWO is a non-profit organization and is registered as a Trust under the Government of Pakistan. It came into existence with the objective of feeding the less fortunate through meals the more fortunate take for granted. Food, being the most basic human need, is denied to many. At RMWO, we intend to begin with addressing this necessity.

Action against Hunger mounted responses to both emergencies while maintaining prior programs in nutrition, food security and water and sanitation across Pakistan. Immediately after the floods, our priority was to contain the spread of waterborne illnesses while working to restore water networks and distribution systems. As a result of our work, nearly 300,000 people were provided with access to clean drinking water after the flood.





④ MEDICAL/HEALTH

RMWO is an NGO providing services of health and education for the poor and needy in Pakistan. The major activities of RMWO includes provision of health care through hospitals and maternal and child health centers. In addition education for children is provided through formal and informal schools. Vocational centers provide computers and vocational training for youth.

Public sector in Pakistan has been deficient in the capacity to deliver equitable and quality health services and thus has been grossly underutilized.





⑤ NATURAL DISASTER

Pakistan has suffered heavily due to floods in its 66-year history, primarily due to the absence of a disaster management mechanism, experts believe.

Resulting from heavy monsoon rains & heavy downpour in the Himalayan foothills. In 2010 one-fifth of Pakistan's total land area was affected by floods & according to Govt data floods directly affected about 20 million people with a death toll of close to 2,000.

RMWO set-up a flood relief camp in Sindh/Pakistan for the affected people from the flood of Sindh river.





⑥ AMBULANCE

Need to Move Patients from Village to Distric Level and then from Distric Level to main Cities in EMERGENCY Case.

In frequent road accidents, sudden disaster, heat stroke, bomb blast, firing, stamped, heavy rain, train collision, building and bridge collapse, unexpected event and emergency, his RMWO Ambulances equipped with first-aid box, oxygen cylinder and paramedics hurriedly rush and always reach the spots FIRST to the rescue of suffering people and for providing them immediate help.





⑦ QURBANI

Collective Qurbani On the occasion of Eid-Ul-Adha'a, RMWO distributes the qurbani meat among congested and the poorest families. The object of collective qurbani is to send meat in long distance areas particularly among them who can't get the meat round the year. In this qurbani occasion 1112 cows & 2927 goats slaughtered during 3 days of qurbani whose meat distributed in poor, deserving & needy families.

RMWO is a non-profit welfare organization set up in 2008 with the vision of supportive aspects to needy people across the nation as well as in the globe.

It has been registered in 2009 from Sindh Govt. of Pakistan and in 2014 registered from Punjab Govt. of Pakistan.
